Preservice Training

September - February Preservice Application Cycle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply for Preservice program • Interview with School of Education Staff • Begin working on Subject Matter requirement (pass at least one subset of CSET and prepare to take remaining CSETs if choosing this route) • Complete Mandated Requirement: U.S. Constitution • Obtain Certificate of Clearance from CTC • Obtain TB test results
March - June	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete Preservice program coursework • Pass remaining CSET subsets
March - August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend SCOE Job Development Workshop • Apply to schools in participating districts

Intern Program

August - December	SEMESTER ONE <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Obtain contract and begin employment as full-time, paid teacher of record • Meet SCOE Coach and begin observation cycle • Begin first semester coursework • Attend TPA (Teaching Performance Assessment) workshops
January - May	SEMESTER TWO <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Begin second semester coursework • Continue Coach Observation Cycle • Attend TPA (Teaching Performance Assessment) workshops

June - August	SUMMER BREAK
August - December	SEMESTER THREE <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Second year as full-time teacher• Begin third semester coursework• Continue Coach Observation Cycle• Attend TPA (Teaching Performance Assessment) workshops
January - April	SEMESTER FOUR <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Begin fourth semester coursework• Finish all coaching obligations• Pass RICA (Reading Instruction Competence Assessment) if Multiple Subject or Education Specialist credential candidate• Complete Red Cross CPR/First Aid• Clear all financial obligations• Once all requirements are complete, apply for a Preliminary Teaching Credential
